COPPER, SILVER, DRASS "TRIO"

A staple of John's act for years. Three different coins magically assemble under two cards. This one will fool you hard.

CMMDS-M-US

Any number of spectator's cards are selected and secretly controlled to the top of the deck. The cards are then found, each in a different and entertaining manner.

John's favorite impromptu routine. The audience always goes crazy!

CLASSIC CUPS AND DALLS

John's take on this classic magic effect. This is John's show closing routine. The lessons learned from John's thinking and structure of the routine will help in all aspects of your magic.
